



## **THE 3<sup>rd</sup> OCEANIA WUSHU CHAMPIONSHIPS (29 Aug 2009)**

### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

The Organizing Committee of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Oceania Wushu Championships is responsible for the organization of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Oceania Wushu Championships under the leadership of the Oceania Wushu Federation (OWUF) Executive Committee. The competition will be a combined event, including the New Zealand Kung-Fu Wushu Federation (NZKWF) National Championships and the Oceania Wushu Federation (OWUF) Continental Championships, hereinafter referred to in this document as the “3<sup>rd</sup> Oceania Wushu Championships”.

#### **1. DATE AND PLACE**

The 3<sup>rd</sup> Oceania Wushu Championships will be held on **Saturday August 29, 2009 (8.30am-5.30pm)**

#### **2. VENUE**

Competition and Training Venue: The NZCT (New Zealand Community Trust) Stadium, Te Rauparaha Arena, 17 Parumoana Street, Porirua, New Zealand.

#### **3. COMPETITION EVENTS**

Competitions will include Taolu (Traditional and Modern) and Sanshou and registration forms are attached for both. Please complete both the Traditional and Modern registration forms. If there are not enough registrations in Modern Taolu then Modern Taolu routines will need to be included in the Traditional Wushu Section. The NZKWF Standard Judging System will be used for the Traditional Wushu Section i.e. Panel or corner judges give a score out of ten from which an average is calculated. The Head Judge makes adjustments (penalties etc) then the final score is recorded out of ten.

#### **4. ENTRIES**

##### **a. Preliminary Entries**

The Preliminary Entry Forms must state the exact number of competitors taking part in the events. And the entries must reach the Organizing Committee of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Oceania Wushu Championships no later than 24:00 (New Zealand Time) **on Monday June 29, 2009**. **b. Final Entry:** The competitors shall fill out the Final Entry Forms. Registration Forms for Movements with Degree of Difficulty of Optional Routines will not be required for this event. The Final Entry Forms shall be printed in two copies. One copy must reach the Organizing Committee of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Oceania Wushu Championships no later than 24:00 (New Zealand Time) **on Wednesday July 29, 2009**. One copy must be brought with the team as confirmation during team registration.

**c.** No changes or additional entries will be accepted after the time limit.

**d.** All entries must be properly typed or printed in English. They are valid only when signed by the President or Secretary General of the respective Federation and bearing the official stamp of the Federation.

#### **5. REGISTRATION**

All participating teams are required to check-in at the Organizing Committee of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Oceania Wushu Championships no later than **16:00 (4.00pm)** (New Zealand Time) **on Thursday August 27, 2009**. The location of the check-in will be at the competition venue. When registering, the participants should settle the relevant fees of the Championships and OWUF membership fee (to be advised), and bring the necessary competition equipment, otherwise, the participants are not allowed to participate in the competition.

## **6. TECHNICAL OFFICIALS**

Each Taolu Team and Sanshou Team can send one National or International Grade Judge. The International Judges (IWUF License holders) must present their valid certificates issued by IWUF to the Organizing Committee for registration. National Judges must also produce verification of being a National License Holder.

## **7. TECHNICAL MEETING**

The Technical Meeting for team managers and coaches will take place at **18:00 (6.00pm)** (New Zealand Time) on **Thursday August 27, 2009**. The location of the technical meeting will be at the competition venue. The meeting will announce the matters related to the competitions. Each team may send up to two representatives for taolu and up to two representatives for sanshou to attend the meeting.

## **8. SANSHOU AND TAOLU JUDGES REFRESHER COURSE**

The above courses will be held between **19:00 (7.00pm) and 21:30 (9.30pm)** (New Zealand Time) on **Thursday August 27, 2009** in meeting rooms 1 (taolu) and 2 (sanshou) at the competition venue. All team officials are welcome to attend to familiarize themselves with the rules of competition. There is no charge for overseas team officials to attend the courses. Certificates of achievement will not be issued to overseas officials as the course is not currently recognized outside of New Zealand.

## **9. OCEANIA WUSHU FEDERATION MEMBER MEETING**

Presidents and/or team leaders or team managers are invited to attend a meeting of Oceania Wushu Federation Country members. This will be held between **12:00 (mid-day) and 14:00 (2.00pm)** (New Zealand Time) on **Friday August 28, 2009** in meeting room 1 at the competition venue.

## **10. DRAWING LOTS CEREMONY**

The drawing-lots of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Oceania Wushu Championships will be conducted by the OWUF Technical Committee at **9:30am** (New Zealand Time) on **Saturday August 29, 2009**. Each team may send up to two taolu and two sanshou representatives to attend the ceremony. The OWUF Technical Committee will draw on behalf of the teams that are unable to send a representative.

Please Note: All efforts will be made to ensure there are sufficient competitors to successfully administer all categories in the event, however the Organizing Committee of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Oceania Wushu Championships accepts no responsibility for the cost of any travel or accommodation arrangements, or other cost or inconvenience, as a result of not being able to organize a suitable opponent or competitor on the day. If necessary, and with your and your coaches' consent, we could look at merging event or weight categories.

#### **11. TEAM TRAINING**

Team training for the 3<sup>rd</sup> Oceania Wushu Championships will be from **14.00 (2.00pm) to 17:00 (5.00pm)** (New Zealand Time) on **Friday 28, 2009**. At this stage the competition venue will be used, however this will need to be confirmed.

#### **12. WEIGHING-IN**

The weighing-in for sanshou athletes will take place between **8.30am and 9.30am** (New Zealand Time) on **Saturday August 29, 2007**.

#### **13. OPENING AND CLOSING CEREMONY**

Due to cost it is not planned at this stage to have an opening or closing ceremony. There will however be an official welcome at the event to all competitors and officials from Australian, Fiji and Guam in appreciation of the special effort they made to attend.

#### **14. FAREWELL DINNER**

Team Leaders, Managers, Coaches, Judges, Other Officials, Competitors and Official Observers are invited to attend a farewell dinner commencing at **19:30 (7.30pm)** (New Zealand Time) on **Saturday 29 August 2009**. The venue will be advised in due course. Due to availability of funds, everyone attending will need to cover their own dinner and alcohol cost and any transportation from and to their accommodation where applicable. We will ensure the dinner is close to the hotel/s to reduce cost and inconvenience.

#### **15. COMPETITION EQUIPMENT**

Team Leaders, Managers, Coaches, Judges, and Competitors should be aware that taolu may need to be performed on a wooden floor. Regrettably this will preclude some taolu 'degree of difficulty movements' due to safety reasons.

The organizers apologise in advance for this, however will make all attempts to secure a taolu carpet before the event. Similarly, sanshou is performed on rubber interlocking mats as opposed to a Lei Tai fighting platform.

## **16. PLACING AND AWARDS**

### **a. Taolu:**

1st place	Gold Medal
2nd place	Silver Medal
3rd place	Bronze Medal

### **b. Sanshou:**

1st place	Gold Medal
2nd place	Silver Medal
3rd place (juxtaposition)	Bronze Medal

As the competition is a combined event with the New Zealand Kung-Fu Wushu Federation Nationals, one side of the medal will state NZKWF National Champion and the other OWUF (Oceania Wushu Federation) Champion. Place getters will technically hold both titles. We also hope to be able to issue Certificates of Participation for all athletes and officials.

## **17. FINANCIAL CONDITIONS**

**a.** All participating teams shall be responsible for their international airfare as well as any domestic airfares within New Zealand. Each team will also be responsible for their accommodation, food and travel.

## **18. ACCOMMODATION**

The Organizing Committee will only be responsible for arranging accommodation from **09:00 (9.00am) on Thursday 27 August, 2009** (New Zealand Time) to **12:00 (12.00pm midnight) Sunday 30 August, 2009** (New Zealand Time). If any teams arrive earlier than the required date or depart later than the required date, they should inform the Organizing Committee at the same time they submit their Final Accommodation Booking Forms. The 3<sup>rd</sup> Oceania Wushu Championships Organizing Committee request that all participating teams should lodge at one of the accommodation outlets suggested below. Preliminary and Final Accommodation Booking Forms are included in this document.

Teams have two options to consider:

Option1: The first option is to tell the Organizing Committee your accommodation needs and we'll do our best to find you suitable accommodation once we have your Final Accommodation Booking Form. Please use the figure of **NZD160 per person per night** when completing the **Final Application Form for Hospitality**, if you want us to try and organize it for you. This is an average cost for a standard studio unit that sleeps two people.

Please note that while we can 'tentatively' book rooms, they would have to be released should a paying customer want to book and pay ahead of receiving your Final Accommodation Booking Form, which is due (New Zealand Time) on **Wednesday July 29, 2009**.

The reason we can only 'tentatively' book is that we don't have the surplus funds to cover the deposit to hold the rooms. The most logical option therefore would be for you to pay the money into our Federation bank account (by international money transfer), at the same time you submit your Final Accommodation Booking Form.

Option 2: The second and perhaps the easiest, is for the Organizing Committee to give you a list of recommended accommodation options for you to look at on the website, and then you can book your accommodation direct on-line or over the phone using a credit card. This will give you the option of booking accommodation to both suit your budget and preferences.

### **Accommodation Options**

## 19. MEALS

The easiest cost option is for each team to organise a daily cooked or continental breakfast when booking accommodation. The cost is reasonable (between NZD10 and NZD15 per person). There are also many food outlets within walking distance of the top two accommodation options listed above. The only organised group meal will be an evening 'farewell dinner' following the competition at between **19:30 (7.30pm)** (New Zealand Time) on **Saturday August 29, 2009**. The dinner will be open to all officials and competitors, however each person will need to cover their own cost for a three course set-menu meal. Please allow approximately NZD45 to NZD50 per person for this expense (excludes alcohol).

## 20. TRANSPORTATION

Members of the Organizing Committee of the 3<sup>rd</sup> Oceania Wushu Championships will meet and greet teams from other countries at the Wellington Airport and will coordinate transportation between Wellington Airport and the team's place of accommodation. At this stage, the cost of transportation from Wellington Airport to Porirua will need to be met collectively by each team.

The cost per person for a 'super shuttle' from the airport to Porirua is around NZD46 for 1<sup>st</sup> person then NZD6.00 per person (after the first person) on a 'shared-ride' basis, where there may be other drop-offs along the way. Alternatively, you can book the exclusive hire of the shuttle for a total of NZD96 each way.

The Organizing Committee will let you know in advance if it is able to arrange alternative transportation or a better rate. If for some reason you want to book your own transport, the Super Shuttle number in New Zealand is 0800-748885 or from overseas +64-9-522-5100. All they need is your pick-up point and the name of the accommodation or street where you want to be taken to.

## **21. OTHER MATTERS**

Each team is required to bring the following:

- a. 1 x National flag, regional flags or federation flags (1m×2m);
- b. 3 x photos (passport size) per team member;
- c. All original Final Entry Forms;
- d. Health Certificates of all athletes and Life Insurance Certificate (country or region);
- e. The 3<sup>rd</sup> Oceania Wushu Championships “Waiver of Liabilities” for each participant.

**Note:** For ease of administration, national flags will not be raised and national anthems or federation songs will not be played during medal presentations. Medal presentations will occur upon conclusion of each event category. We will endeavor to arrange certificates of participation for athletes and officials.

## **22. SIGHT-SEEING**

At this stage there has been no arrangement to include sight-seeing into the programme however we will be happy to recommend and/or assist you with any sight-seeing arrangements you may wish to make, before or after the competition. Feel free to browse any New Zealand sight-seeing website for ideas.

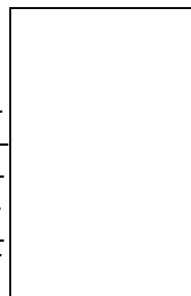

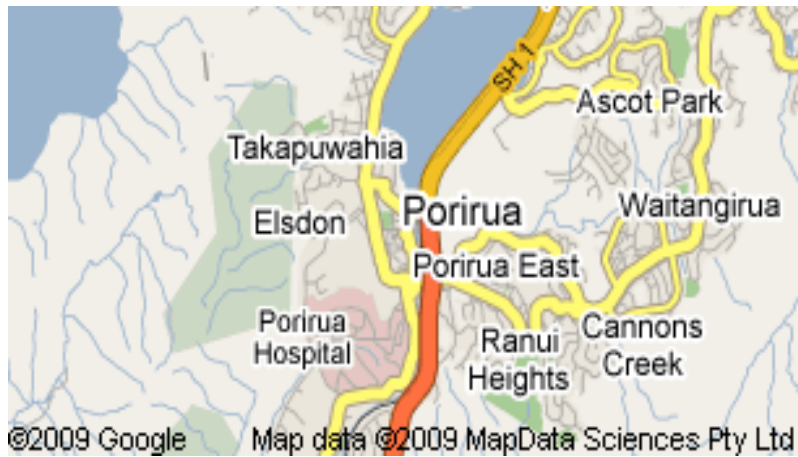
